SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAMS

What are the Codington-Clark Electric Cooperative Scholarship Programs?

The Codington-Clark Electric Cooperative Scholarship Programs are designed to recognize certain academic achievements by children of member-consumers of Codington-Clark Electric, to encourage students to attend a **South Dakota** post-secondary institute which we feel will encourage them to stay in South Dakota.

The recognition will be in the form of scholarships.

How much are the scholarships?

There are three scholarships available. Two \$500 Codington-Clark Electric Scholarships and one Codington-Clark Electric / CoBank Scholarship in the amount of \$1,000. The scholarships must be used for educational costs, and the student must enter college in the fall of the school year for which the scholarship is given. Checks will be made payable to the student, and will be distributed by Codington-Clark Electric.

Codington-Clark Electric will pay scholarships after the completion of the first semester.

Who is eligible to receive the scholarship?

Dependent children of member-system consumers are eligible. The applicant must also be a U.S. citizen.

The applicant must be a student who is planning to enroll in a full-time undergraduate course of study at an accredited, two-year or four-year college, university, or vocational/technical school **located in South Dakota.**

How are the recipients selected?

Awards are based on the following criteria: a minimum grade-point average of 2.0, a statement of 100 words or less by the student explaining his/her educational and career goals, and two recommendations by third parties.

What are the recipient's obligations?

Except for the requirements outlined in this brochure, no obligations will be imposed upon the student as a scholarship award winner. Other than payment of the scholarship, no obligations or liability are assumed by Codington-Clark Electric Cooperative, Inc.

How can I apply?

To apply, you must complete the required criteria and the scholarship application, which can be obtained from the cooperative website or from the school counselor. A single application covers both scholarships.

Children of member-consumers must return applications to Codington-Clark Electric's Service Center by February 15, 2017.

The applicant is responsible for submitting all necessary information to apply for a scholarship. The applications must reach your cooperative by the given deadline.
